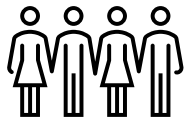


- MASKS

- SPECIAL ENTERING AND LEAVING THE CHURCH

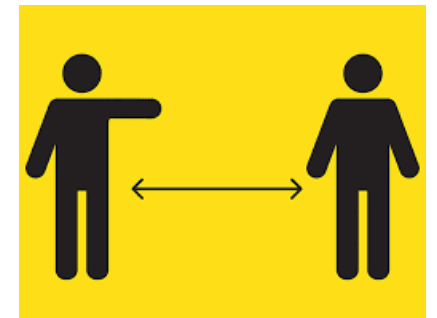

# WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT IN CHURCH?

- MASKS WILL BE WORN BY ALL  
(Forgot yours? Church will have some)



- HOUSEHOLDS WILL BE SEATED TOGETHER  
(You determine who is in your "household")
- SOCIAL DISTANCING - 6 FEET IN ALL SPACES  
Sanctuary is **limited to 25**  
Fellowship Hall - additional service space up to 25



# WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT IN CHURCH? (con't)

- ENTRY WAY AND EXIT WAY WILL BE CLEARLY MARKED VIA ROPING



- ALL BATHROOMS WILL BE OPEN FOR USE WITH ADDITIONAL SANITIZING STATIONS AT DOORWAYS



- SEATING WILL BE DONE USING THE "FRONT TO BACK" METHOD FOR SEATING AND THE "BACK TO FRONT" FOR DISMISSING EACH PEW



# WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT IN CHURCH? (con't)

- NO PEW PADS - ATTENDANCE WILL BE DONE BY USHERS
- AN "OFFERING BOX" WILL BE AT THE ENTRANCE & EXIT  
(Offering plate will not be passed during service)
- COMMUNION WILL BE THE SAME AS THE OUTSIDE SERVICE  
YOU BRING YOUR OWN PIECE OF BREAD  
AND PASTOR WILL CONSECRATE YOUR BREAD DURING THE SERVICE



# WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT IN CHURCH? (con't)

- BIBLES, HYMNALS WILL NOT BE IN PEWS

✓ You are welcome to bring your own



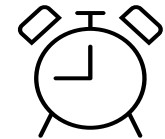
- NO SINGING OR MUSIC AT THIS TIME

- SPECIAL OFFERING ENVELOPES WILL BE AVAILABLE FROM USHERS

# WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT IN CHURCH? (con't)

- **ADDITIONAL SAFETY MEASURES:**

- ❖ SERVICE WILL BE ABOUT ONE (1) HOUR



- ❖ VENTILATION - ALL CEILING FANS AND WALL UNITS WILL BE IN USE



- ✓ You may need to bring a sweater

- ❖ KITCHEN & WATER FOUNTAINS WILL NOT BE IN USE

- ✓ Complimentary bottled water will be provided



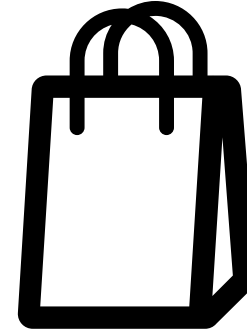

PEN/PENCIL

PERSONAL SIZED HAND SANITIZER

PERSONAL TISSUES

SWEATER OR WRAP IF YOU ARE SENSITIVE TO COOL AIR





# HOW DO I DECIDE?



DO I HAVE A FEVER OR CHILLS?

DO I HAVE A COUGH? SORE THROAT? CONGESTION? RUNNY NOSE?

DO I HAVE SHORTNESS OF BREATH OR DIFFICULTY BREATHING?

DO I HAVE FATIGUE?

DO MY MUSCLES OR BODY ACHES ALL OVER?

AM I NAUSEOUS OR VOMITING?

I HAVE BEEN ADVISED BY MY HEALTH CARE PROVIDER TO STAY HOME

I HAVE CONDITIONS THAT PREVENT ME FROM WEARING A MASK FOR 1 HOUR

I AM JUST NOT COMFORTABLE TO DO AN INDOOR EVENT

**IF THE ANSWER IS "YES" TO ANY,**
