Executive Committee elected: President Brad Neil, Vice President Carol Ranck, Secretary Deb Flage, and Treasurer Jim Lubrecht. Members of Council include: Steve Barron, Jeanette Logan, Joel Hains, Sandy Moritz, and Penny Zimmerman.

Pastor Beth Martini, Assistant to the Synod Bishop, provided information in proceeding with securing pastoral services while Our Saviour Lutheran Church (OSL) determines all of its options and next steps as we look to our future. Synod has identified a proposed part-time interim pastor who is available. Some of you may know Pastor Frank Terhune. He served as interim pastor at Epiphany Lutheran a couple years ago, visited us as a Supply Pastor, and attended an event we held in our Fellowship Hall.
