Easter Egg Making 2022



Easter egg making has begun!

At this time, we are only taking orders for peanut butter eggs covered in milk chocolate. However, we will soon also be making coconut cream eggs covered in dark chocolate. We will send out a notification when coconut cream eggs are available.

The committee met on January 25, 2022, and decided to keep the eggs the same size, but to increase the price to \$1.25, per egg, due to increased costs of ingredients. Please check on places where you previously sold eggs and let them know of the price increase. We are always looking for new places to sell our eggs. We must SELL, SELL, SELL our eggs to make this project a success!

We are excited to be resuming the egg making project this year. With the support of our volunteer teams and church members, we strive to make this year's project successful. Needless to say, it is a big undertaking to fill the shoes of Connie Johnson and Julie Drake.

Teams have been organized, but we are still looking for additional volunteers. Please contact either Donna or Nadine if you would like to volunteer. We currently have 3 teams: Saturday Team - Nadine Martin (leader), Sunday Team - Alice Lubrecht (leader), and Thursday Team - Donna Miller (leader). If you are on a team but are unable to be at your team's scheduled egg-making session, please let your team leader know. All volunteers are asked to adhere to the following safety protocols:

- Team Leaders are responsible for logging their team's attendance in the attendance log for each egg making session.
- All volunteers are required to wear a mask.
- All volunteers are required to wear a hairnet or hat.
- All volunteers are required to wash their hands in the hand washing sink prior to starting any egg-making tasks.
- All volunteers must wear plastic/latex gloves. Should gloves become soiled, torn, or contaminated, gloves must be discarded and replaced with a new set.
- No eating or drinking permitted in areas where eggs are being

processed.

- When possible, all volunteers are encouraged to maintain social distance.
- All touch points within the kitchen and social hall must be sanitized at the conclusion of the egg making session.
